#### 2. UPDATE ON RAFA IT

Sgt Wayne 'Swiggsy' Swiggs, one of the RAFALO members of RAFA CC has been working very hard on updating RAFA's IT and thought you would appreciate sight of just some of the work he puts in on our behalf. Below are the edited highlights of Swiggsy's 'quick' update ref RAFA IT...

The TCW 90SU Branch portal has gone live (<a href="http://www.tcwand90su.co.uk">http://www.tcwand90su.co.uk</a>) but will be subject to further tweaks in coming weeks. The portal adopts the same look and feel as the main RAFA website as it was designed by the same web design company. The aim is to 'encourage' all Branches to create or migrate to a RAFA led Branch portal. I believe this will undoubtedly improve brand consistency and our professional outlook and outreach. I have been working with CHQ to streamline the proforma needed to facilitate future Branch requests. My current Branch Aphrodite is in the process of requesting a portal via the draft form. Once Aphrodite Branch is live and the process reviewed, RAFA will look to engage/communicate with the Branches. Cost to Branch from flash to bang is circa £400. When you consider the costs of employing a professional web design agency, this is great value for money. I am sure you will have lots of questions about this project I.e. ongoing management, changing the template etc but at this juncture, I would ask you to park them until the project is more mature. I have asked an inordinate amount of questions, outlined a number of strict requirements and I don't want to saturate our excellent staff.

2. Customer Relationship Management system, essentially this project will centralise RAFA's many data silos, streamline processes and provide a very powerful reporting tool for trend analysis and KPI dashboard monitor key areas.
