- Twin/double room based on 2 sharing £117.95 per person for 2 nights bed and breakfast, Friday evening forked buffet and Saturday evening Dinner.
- Single room £152.95 for 2 nights bed and breakfast, Friday evening forked buffet and Saturday evening Dinner.
- One twin/double room based on 2 sharing for just the Saturday night including the formal Saturday evening Dinner and Sunday breakfast is £62.50 per person.
- One single room for just the Saturday night including the formal Saturday evening Dinner and Sunday breakfast is £80.00.
- If you wish to come along just for the Saturday evening Dinner, this will be £25 per person. Please let the Exeter Office know if this is your plan as we shall need to keep an eye on additional seats over and above those that have booked for the weekend.
