Secretaries will note that the F1056A has provision for full names to be entered. The Charity Commission insists on these details on the Branch Charity Trustee Form which is part of the Annual Update – these are not available to the public. These forms should be returned to us as soon as possible after your AGM, together with a copy of your Branch/Club Audited Accounts for 2013 please – see item 4 below. As well as being a requirement of the Association, the detail from these accounts is required when completing Charity Commission updates.

Branches are reminded that in accordance with Standard Branch Regulation 32, Accounts as at 31 December 2013, including a Report from the Auditor or Independent Examiner, for both Branch and Branch Clubs are to be received at Area Headquarters by 31 March 2014. Would Treasurers

# 9. A REMINDER TO BRANCHES – FIRST CONTACT WITH NEW SERVING MEMBERS
