# 1. RAF ASSOCIATION APPOINTS A NEW HEAD

On Saturday 15 February 2014, the Central Council of the RAF Association approved the appointment of Mr Nick Bunting as Secretary General, with effect from 3 March 2014. Chairman of Trustees, Air Vice-Marshal Nigel Bairsto said: "We are delighted to welcome Nick Bunting to the Association in this important role. You will see from his biography below that Nick has skills and experience from the commercial and charitable sectors to bring to the RAF Association's mission to support members and welfare beneficiaries in the RAF family.

"I would also like to take this opportunity to thank Jane Easton for her immense contribution over the last three and a half years, and to wish her well in her new role."

Nick started his career with Cadbury's where he held a number of sales, production, marketing, management and operational roles. He then went on to work for Guinness running the on-trade operations, Pepsico where he led the licensed trade function and the home baking side of Whitworths; before becoming part of a management buy-out of the dry dog food division of Dalgety. As the Sales and Marketing Director he created the largest supplier of own label dog food in the UK. His sporting passions have always been rugby union and motor sports. He played rugby until a motorcycle accident resulted in a rethink. Nick then became a referee, where he represented the Rugby Football Union (RFU) and was appointed as the northern hemisphere referee representative on the International Rugby Board.

Taking the opportunity to do his hobby for a living, Nick joined the RFU to lead the development of refereeing. He spent 14 years, in a variety of roles, latterly, as a member of the Executive Committee, as the Head of Public Affairs and Operations, generating over £200m of inward investment into the sport for community based activity and facility development. On leaving the RFU Nick became Chief Executive of one of His Royal Highness, The Prince of Wales' charities. He developed and expanded the charity to reach more of its target group of the unemployed over 50s, creating over 2,000 new businesses and 3,000 jobs. Latterly, he was the Chief Executive of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association, where as the Chief Executive, he led the organisation through a period of transformation.

Both Nick's father and brother served in the RAF, and his sister-in-law was a commercial pilot, so he has a natural affinity for all things aviation. Outside work Nick has held a Ministerial appointment, several non-executive directorships and acted as a trustee for a range of charities.

Nick takes over the position from Jane Easton, who led the charity through a major restructure during her three and a half year tenure.
